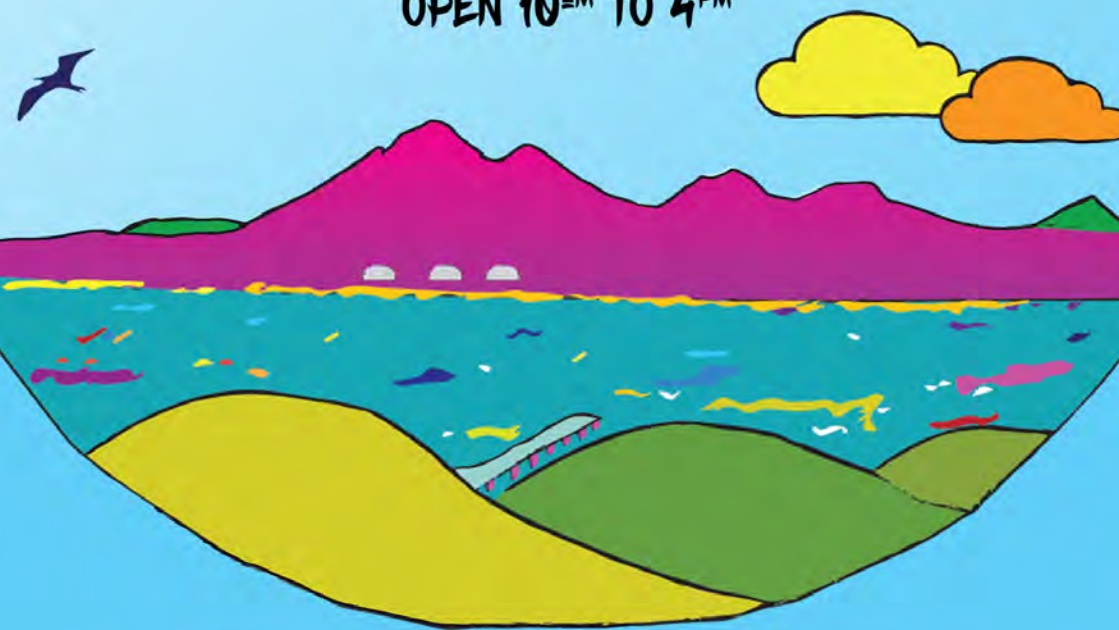

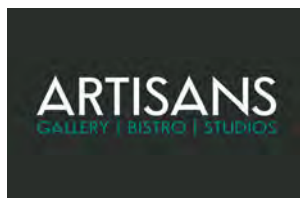

OUR TIPS FOR TRAVELLING THE NBAT 2025

We know it can seem like an impossible task to visit all the venues on the trail, and have enough time at each one to enjoy the stunning pieces on display, so we have come up with some tips for how to get the most out of your day.

-  Start in any location, then continue visiting the venues in sequence, you will find a natural route between them and spend less time driving and more time enjoying the art
-  Spend between 20-30mins in each solo venue and allow 30 - 60mins for the group venues
-  There is an online version of this map available from the Bellarine Peninsula Arts website and on the NBAT Facebook page - it will take all the hard work out of your planning. You can also use the maps in this booklet as well as your trusty GPS to navigate around trail
-  Many venues will have some form of eftpos machine, but not all. It is a good idea to bring some cash with you, as there are many things to see and buy on your day out.
-  Bring your camera or phone - check with the artist - take shots of pieces that you love - then share them on the socials and tag NBAT25 and the artist!

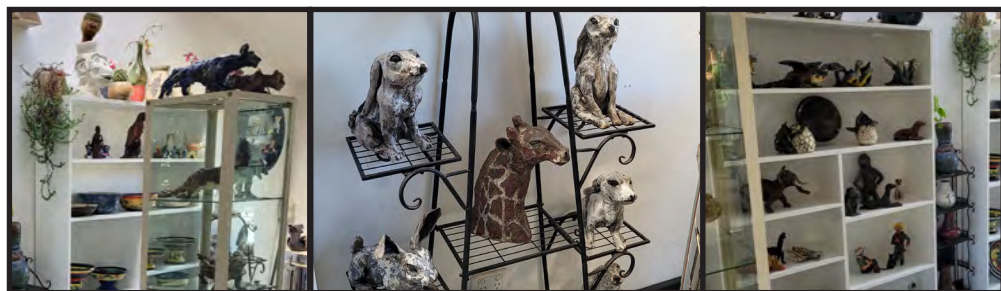

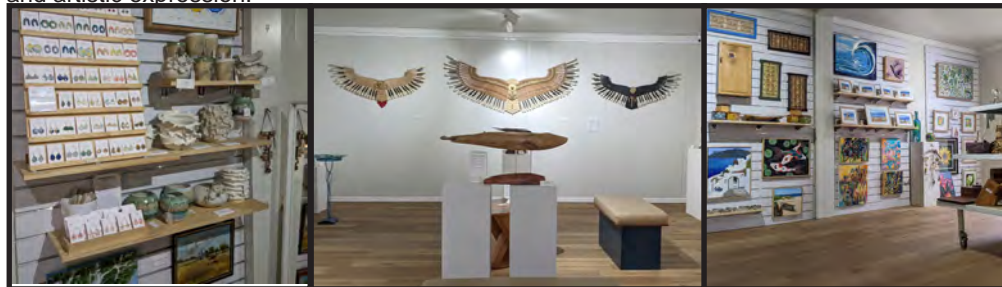


ARTISANS OF AUSTRALIA - OVERVIEW
